JOB DESCRIPTIONS

Thursday Morning Helpers

- Helpers move bags of goods at 401 Richmond St. W.
- o This job requires strength and stamina but helpers have great fun.

Thursday Evening Helpers

- Helpers load trucks with bags of goods at 401 Richmond St. W. or at other locations.
- This job requires strength and stamina but helpers have great fun.

Sales Helpers

- o They help customers select goods.
- o They restock goods and make the displays attractive.
- Standing is required to do this job but helpers can rest occasionally on portable stools.

Cashiers

- Cashiers tally up dollar amounts. They can use calculators available at each cash desk.
- o They use a charge machine or cash box.
- They give change.
- They can sit while doing this job.

Assistant Cashiers

- They tell prices to a cashier.
- They bag items.
- They put PAID stickers on bags.
- o They give customers a "two for one" pass.
- They sometimes stand and sometimes sit.

Stock Helpers

- They carry bags and deliver goods from the truck to sales areas.
- o They help where needed.
- This job requires strength and stamina.

Clean Up Helpers

- At the Textile Museum, they help put away equipment, clean up the area where the Sale was held, load up the truck with leftover goods and unload the truck at 401 Richmond St. W.
- This job requires strength and stamina.
